Course A: Software Systems for Astronomy: MTWRF 9:00 AM - 11:45 AM 2 credits

An emphasis on telescope and instrument control systems, planning and analysis software. Students will work with existing software tools and design methodologies.

Course B: Applied Software Systems for Astronomy: MTWRF 1:00 PM - 3:45 PM 2 credits

In applied systems, student operate existing software and implement software designs, tools and data from Course A.

Course C: Preparation for Research and Work in Maunakea Astronomy: MTWRF 4:00 PM - 6:45 PM 2 credits. In this hands on research course, students will work on astronomy projects from inception of the scientific problem to the experimental design. Course will include a visit to Maunakea observatories, weather pending.

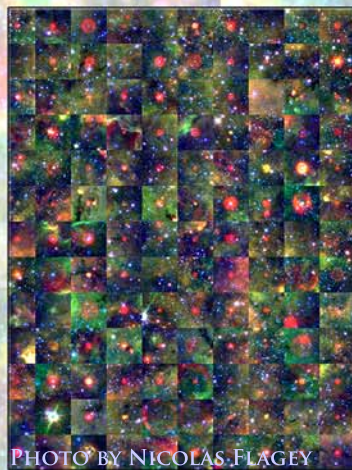
